Verint Enterprise VMS 7.5 SP1 continues to deliver a robust video management software that responds to the evolving security needs of organizations. With each release of Verint VMS, a corresponding Verint HDR 1800 and HDR-P firmware file is provided. You must download and install the firmware file prior to upgrading Verint VMS. For users upgrading to the current version, the .NET framework 4.5.1 is required for VMS Review workstations.

Descriptions

VMS Review can now overlay visual information coming from video analytics on top of playing video and as part of an alarm attachment. Multiple cameras can show overlay metadata simultaneously, and the overlay display can be turned on and off per user. Overlay also appears when using the playback controls to browse within the video.

Verint VMS now supports ONVIF Profile G, which enables retrieving video from a camera's SD card to fill in gaps on the Recorder (for cameras that are compliant with ONVIF Profile G).

Dewarping is now supported in Review for Panasonic 360° (fisheye) cameras.

The Review user interface now supports Thai and Hebrew.

This release includes the IP Camera Plugin Package version 1.2.

Verint VMS can now retrieve video from Axis cameras to fill in gaps on the recorder.
